

Class Descriptions – Little Folk School 2020

Amazing Masks - *Claire Oliphant* – Learn to design, create, decorate, and display masks in a variety of styles. We will look at masks from all over the world and throughout history. Bring your creative mind!

Basketry: Baskets and Boxes - *Nancy Hinds* – Create several different and colorful baskets and boxes using a variety of materials like cereal boxes, painted paper, fabric and beads.

Book Arts: Books, Boxes and More - *Ida Palmer-Ball* – Design beautiful papers that will turn into cool books, boxes, and bags. Take home a portfolio of work to make even more at home.

Clay: Let's Get Dirty! - *Ken Shipley* – Learn to make painted cups, bowls, animals, or any creature you can think of out of clay.

Cornshuck Creativity - *Mary Rutherford* - Use your imagination to turn colorful corn husks into a-MAZE-ing characters. Anna, Elsa, Obi-Wan Kenobi, Blackbeard the Pirate, Darth Vader or even a baby Yoda are just a few of the characters you can make! Enjoy repurposing corn husks into fun and creative works of art.

Drawing: Working with Pen and Pencil - *Pattie Bagley* - Would you like to learn how to draw like a real artist with a pen or pencil? Come and spend the week with Ms. Pattie and learn how to make your drawings come to life.

Gourd Art: Magical Gourd House –*Linda Vanderlaan* - Learn how to make a gourd house that doubles as a night light. You will be able to paint and decorate your very own Hobbit or Fairy house.

Hodge-Podge Collage - *Lisa Chentfant* - Cut, paint and glue different shapes, textures, and colors together to make one-of-a-kind works of art. Work with paper, metal, fabric, and other items to create unique artwork. You'll even collage your own trinket box.

Magic - *Tom Payne* - Amaze and entertain family and friends with magic. Learn a variety of tricks using cards, rope, money, paper clips and so much more.

Paper Arts: Paper Packages with Surprises - *Lynn Ann Miller* - Learn to make widgets, gismos and thingamabobs that will hide right in your decorated box and container. Every day will be an adventure learning different techniques to make one-of-a-kind gifts for yourself or others.

Recycled Critters and Creations - *Shari Shifrin* - Learn how to repurpose everyday materials into mountain critters! Create a rainbow trout, hedgehogs and even your very own totem pole using ordinary household items that you would normally into the trash.
